POLK ELEMENTARY DRESS CODE

Dear Polk Parents,

With spring in the air, we ask that you read and discuss our dress code with your child/children. Please visit our website at [www.http://district7.net/](http://www.district7.net/) to read the entire dress code and for other information about Polk.

1. The student is dressed and groomed appropriately.
 - *appropriately fitting clothing (i.e. no excessively tight or baggy clothes and no short shorts)*
 - *modest clothing (i.e. no revealing items like belly shirts, tank tops or shirts with spaghetti straps)*
 - *uncovered heads (i.e. no hats or hoods)*
 - *prescription glasses as needed (i.e. no sunglasses)*
2. The student is wearing no makeup or unnatural hair color or style (i.e. no Mohawks).
3. The student is wearing no obscene, profane, or otherwise objectionable or inappropriate clothing.
4. The student is dressed appropriately for the weather.
5. The student is wearing footwear that is safe for the school environment (i.e. no backless shoes such as flip flops, clogs, or slides—these types of shoes are unsafe for gym class and for recess).

Students who do not follow the dress code could be sent home or home could be called to bring appropriate clothing or footwear. Student safety is our first priority! Thank you for your ongoing support!
