### IMPORTANT FINE INFORMATION





### SCHOOLS OF CHOICE INFORMATION/ENROLL AT BOARD OF EDUCATION OFFICE

As we begin to plan for the 2017-18 school year, our enrollment will be unlimited for students K-11, with limited enrollment for grade 12. The registration period for grades K-11 will be Monday, April 10 through Friday, August 18, 2017. The registration period for grade 12 was Monday, April 24 through Friday, May 12, 2017.

Grades Kindergarten - 11th: Unlimited Enrollment April 10 through August 18, 2017

Grade 12: Limited Enrollment April 24 through May 12, 2017

Registration times at Board Office is 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

## FROM THE DESK OF MR. BRENTON SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

(Students are chosen by teacher recommendation.)

Summer school will be held at Polk Elementary from Monday, June 26 through Thursday, July 27. Breakfast will be served each day. The program will run daily Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. No summer school on Monday, July 3rd and Tuesday, July 4th.

Summer school will include 8 classrooms; two each of kindergarten and 1st grade, and one each 2nd through 5th grades. The program is roughly 90 minutes of targeted English Language Arts instruction, 75 minutes of mathematics instruction, and a short break for students to get some fresh air (weather permitting).

Each classroom is staffed by a certified teacher and a paraprofessional, so students will spend a large portion of their time in small groups or receiving individualized instruction from one of the adults in their classroom.
