Dear Families,

Math: We will review for the Unit 3 test next Monday. **The test will be on Tuesday, November 11th.**

We will also begin Unit 4 next week. There will be discussion and practice of change-to-more number stories, and parts-and-total number stories.

Students will also participate in Math Centers as extensions to the concepts covered.

Writer's Workshop:

Students will finish up with their two paragraph writing and begin drafting a small moment story.

Daily 5: Next week students will continue to learn about fantasy and practice using the literacy elements to retell the stories.

Students will also participate in a variety of activities to practice this skill and review previously taught skills.

Grammar: Next week we will review plural and possessive nouns:

Plural-The **boys** are going on a picnic.

Singular possessive-The **boy's** coat was on the bed.

Plural possessive-The **boys'** coats are on the bus.

Social Studies: Next week students will begin to look at different land and water forms that make up the earth. We will read and discuss these forms as well as begin to create a land and water forms book.

Science Next week students will finish their study and investigation of force and motion.

They will review concepts learned from this unit next week and take a quiz on the content that was covered.
