Dear Families,

Math: Next week students will continue to work on addition and subtraction skills. They will work on different strategies to add multi-digit numbers mentally and look at measuring lengths and distances to the nearest inch and centimeter, explore area, and sort attribute blocks according to rules.

Students will also participate in Math Centers as extensions to the concepts covered.

Writer's Workshop:

Next week in Writer's Workshop the students will create a one paragraph writing piece about Thanksgiving.

Daily 5: Students will continue to review fantasy features and practice using the literacy elements to retell the stories.

Students will also participate in a variety of activities to practice this skill and review previously taught skills.

Grammar: Next week we will review nouns and verbs.

Social Studies: Next week students will continue to learn about land and water forms. They will finish creating their land and water form book as well as begin creating a second grade land and water form mural. They will also learn
